<p>1. Topics Covered</p> <p>a. Parts of Speech:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Explained the eight parts of speech: nouns, pronouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs, prepositions, conjunctions, and interjections. - Conducted exercises to identify parts of speech in sentences. <p>b. PowerPoint Presentation Basics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Taught the fundamentals of creating a PowerPoint presentation. - Covered topics such as slide creation, formatting text, inserting images, and transitions. - Demonstrated how to structure a presentation effectively (Introduction, Body, and Conclusion). <p>c. Excel Basics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Explained the interface of Microsoft Excel. - Taught how to create tables, use basic formulas (SUM, AVERAGE, etc.), and format cells. - Demonstrated real-life applications such as maintaining attendance records or expense sheets. <p>d. Reading Sessions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Conducted interactive reading sessions to improve students’ fluency and comprehension. - Encouraged group reading and discussion to enhance engagement. <p>Topic: Creative Writing</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● What is Creative Writing? Creative writing is the art of crafting original written content that emphasizes imagination, originality, and self-expression. It includes forms like fiction, poetry, drama, personal essays, and more. Enhance Imagination: Encourage writers to think outside the box and develop unique ideas. 2. Improve Expression: Help individuals articulate thoughts, emotions, and stories effectively. 3. Develop Voice and Style: Foster a unique writing style and personal voice. 4. Boost Communication Skills: Strengthen the ability to convey complex ideas and emotions. 5. Encourage Critical Thinking: Challenge writers to create believable plots, characters, and scenarios.
