The garbage disposal is mounted to the underside of a sink and is designed to collect solid food waste in a grinding chamber. Introduction

Medahalli, a rural area with limited access to educational resources, has traditionally faced challenges in achieving high academic performance in the Secondary School Leaving Certificate (SSLC) examinations. Recognizing the need for targeted intervention, a comprehensive program was implemented to improve SSLC results for students in this region. This report outlines the steps taken, the methodologies adopted, and the outcomes achieved through this initiative.

Program Implementation

1. Needs Assessment and Baseline Survey Before the program's inception, a detailed needs assessment was conducted to understand the specific challenges faced by students in Medahalli. This involved: • Conducting surveys and interviews with students, parents, and teachers. • Analysing past SSLC performance data to identify areas of weakness. • Evaluating the availability and quality of educational resources.
