MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is executed on 12/02/2024, between:

Center of Excellence and Internship Training Provider:

Quantum Learnings, a company registered under the laws of [Jurisdiction], having its principal place of business at [House 193, Vinobha Puri 3rd Floor, Lajpat Nagar Part II New Delhi 110024, represented by Mr. Sandeep Giyyan J Jethani, (hereinafter referred to as the "Provider").

Institution:

East Point College of Engineering and Technology, approved by All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi and affiliated to Visvesvaraya Technological University, Belgavi, registered under the laws of [Recognized by Govt. of Karnataka], having its principal place of business at Jnanaprabha, East Point Campus, Virgo Nagar Post, Avalahalli, Bengaluru, represented by Dr. Mrityunjaya V Latte, Principal, East Point College of Engineering and Technology (hereinafter referred to as the "Institution"). (Provider and Institution may collectively be referred to as the "Parties").

WHEREAS, the Provider offers educational programs and certifications for students, including Center of Excellence and Internship Training, and the Institution desires to collaborate with the Provider to offer such programs to its students;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

1. Purpose of Agreement

1.1 The Provider agrees to collaborate with the Institution to offer **Center of Excellence and Internship Training Programs**, as specified in the annexed Schedule A (Program Offerings).

2. Financial Arrangements

2.1 The Institution commits to enrolling a _____ minimum number of students for the Center of Excellence and Internship Training as outlined in Schedule B & C (Enrolment Slabs) within an academic year. The Institution shall be eligible for pricing and benefits based on the corresponding slab as set forth in Schedule B.

2.2 The Institution acknowledges that certain **Center of Excellence and Internship Training Programs** may be partially funded through Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) funding, as specified in Schedule C (Additional Benefits).

3. MOU Tenure and Renewal

3.1 This MOU shall have a minimum tenure of three (3) years, commencing on the Effective Date 12/02/2024 and terminating on 11/02/2027, subject to renewal as set forth in Schedule D (MOU Tenure).

4. Program Implementation and Training

4.1 The Provider shall conduct the Center of Excellence and Internship Training Programs online or in a hybrid mode only based on the slabs chosen by the Institution, as mutually agreed upon.

4.2 The Institution agrees that, in the case of bulk programs, payment for the committed number of students shall be provided in a single payment as per the terms outlined in Schedule E (Payment Terms).

5. Reporting and Goals

- 5.1 The Institution shall communicate student goals to the Provider and allocate Center of Excellence and Internship Training Programs based on the list provided by the Provider.
- 5.2 The Institution shall be able to generate consolidated student performance reports as per the format provided by provider.

6. Batch Management

6.1. Batches for Center of Excellence and Internship Training Programs may consist of students from different institutions based on factors such as the cost of faculty, resource availability for the specific technology skill, and other overheads. It should not be assumed that any batch will exclusively comprise students from a particular institution.

7. Certificate Issuance

7.1. All certificates for the Center of Excellence and Internship Training Programs will be issued in electronic format and automatically delivered to the students' accounts upon successful completion.

8. Batch Scheduling

8.1. Batch schedules for Center of Excellence and Internship Training Programs will be provided based on the availability of trainers and the demand for a particular program. However, within an academic year, different programs will be offered based on the demand from the list specified in the MOU.

9. Offline Sessions

9.1. For the corresponding number of offline sessions as provided in the enrolment slabs, these sessions will be conducted for a predefined number of days. In case additional days are required for offline sessions, such additional days will incur an extra cost for the trainer. Offline sessions are generally scheduled for weekends, as most colleges and institutions have available infrastructure during that time. Subject matter experts are typically working professionals, and their availability is higher on weekends.

10. Payment Terms

10.1. Payments for the Center of Excellence and Internship Training Programs must be made in full, in advance, as specified in the MOU. No changes or modifications to the payment terms will be allowed once agreed upon.

11. License for Centre of Excellence

11.1 The Institution shall receive a campus-wise Centre of Excellence (COE) license for students and faculties, as determined by the total campus strength, as mentioned in Schedule H (COE License).

18. International Certifications

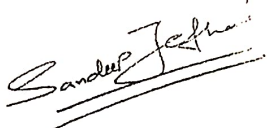

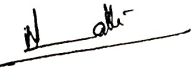
