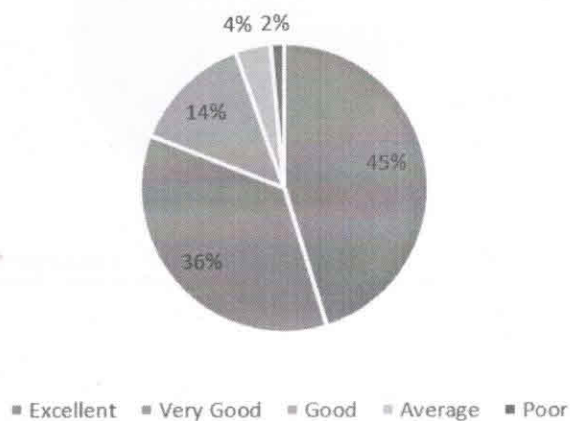

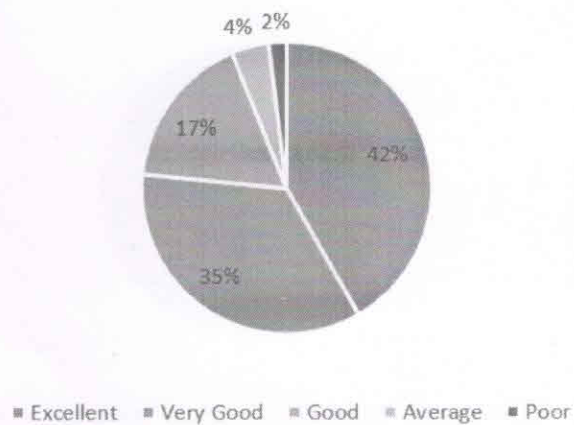

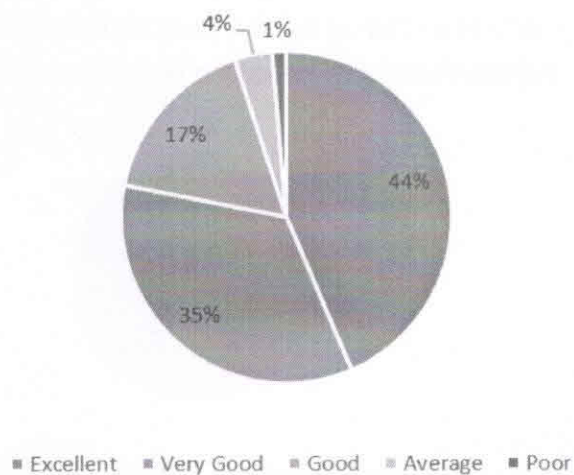

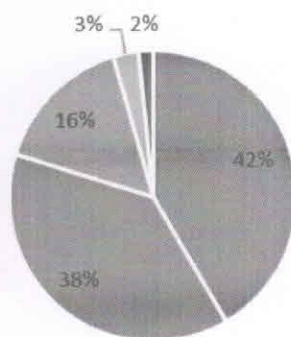

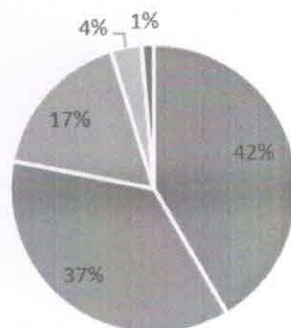


Relevance of programme for career avenues in future



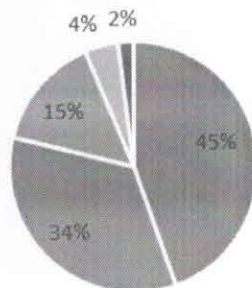

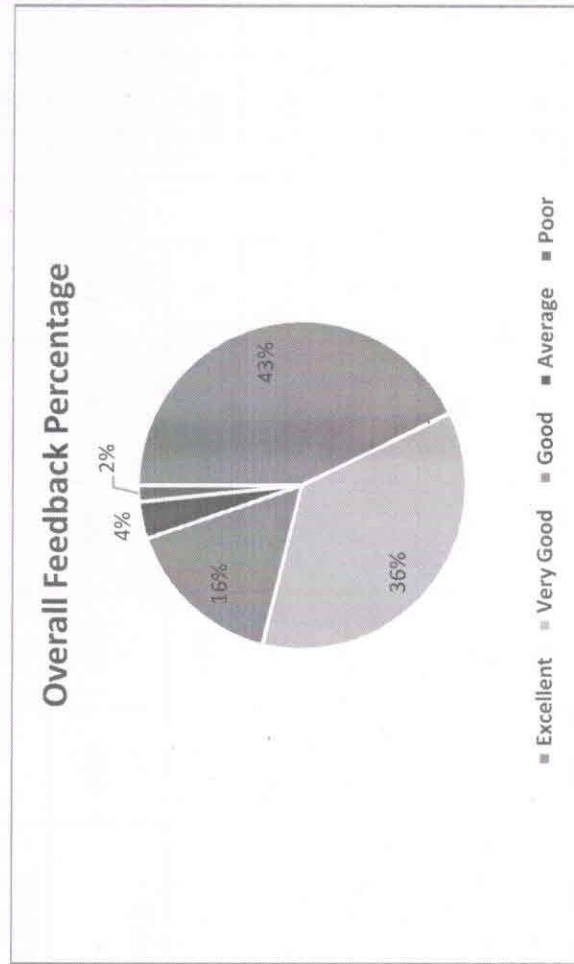
